

CBC 3 Year Capital Campaign Fund – “Resourcing & Renewing”



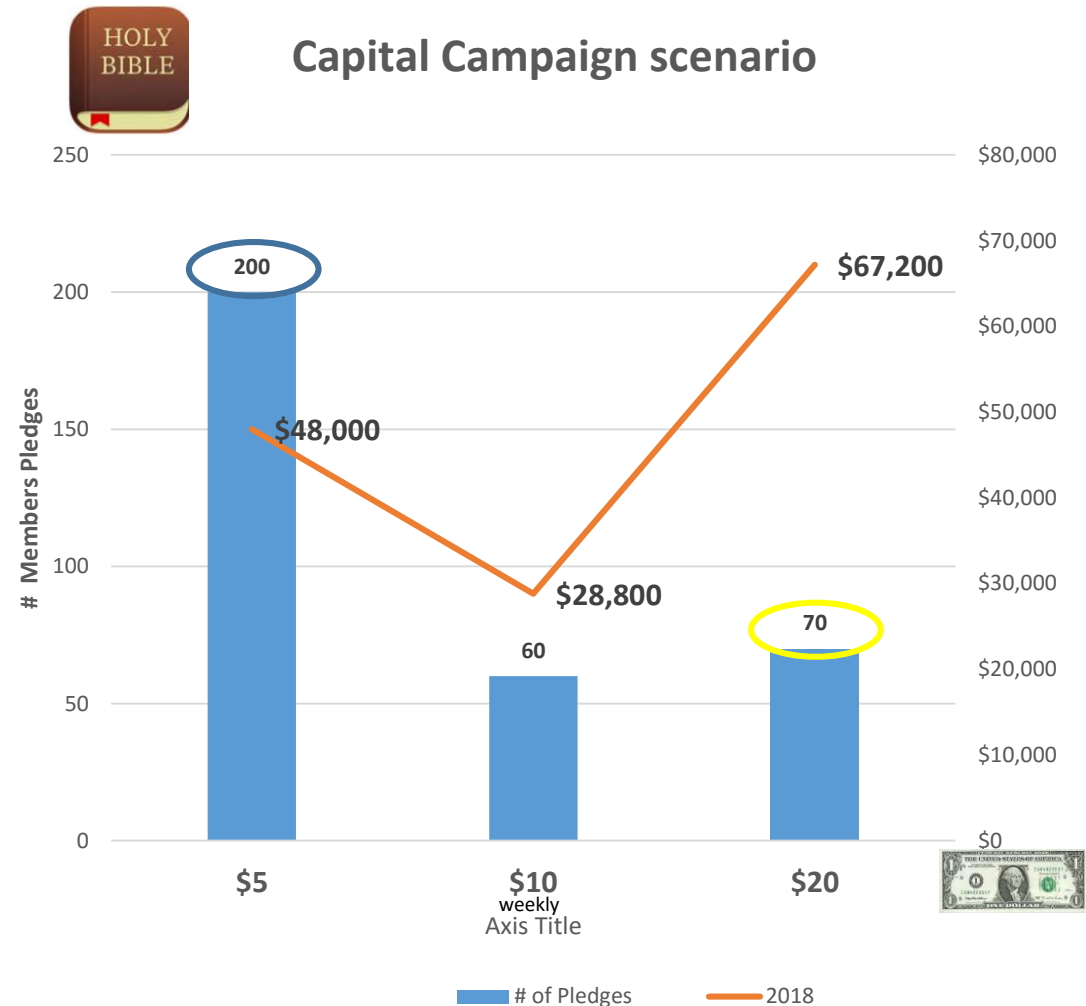
- ✓ In Obedience to God, CBC Finance leaders will supervise and manage funds for below capital projects
